

Warren Township Supervisors- Minutes Regular Monthly Meeting- April 6th, 2026 5pm

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, William Franklin. Supervisors present were, William Franklin, Mark Wheaton and Matt Wilks. Also, present were Lori Kepner, secretary/treasurer, and Joe Vrabel Roadmaster. There were a several members of the public present at the meeting. The Olmstead's asked to be on the agenda to speak about the Cruise In (Sept 20th). They just wanted to introduce themselves as the new contacts for the Cruise In for this year. The Township is in support of the yearly function. The visitors list will be attached to the minutes. Mike Haas was present from Delta Engineers to review the grant application and questions they had for the new walk path at the Township. After 40 minutes of conversations, the board made a motion by Franklin to hold a special meeting on April 16th, 2026 at 5pm to make any final motions on the walk path if needed. Wheaton seconded and all agreed. Kepner will advertise the special meeting.

Minutes: A motion was made by Wheaton to accept the March 2, 2026 Regular Meeting minutes. Wilks seconded and all agreed.

Fire Dept and EMA: There was nothing new to report. The BC EM plan support resolution will be ready at the May Twp meeting.

Road Report: Joe Vrabel gave the road report. They have been plowing/cindering during the storms. They started cutting the brush back and have maintain equipment as needed. Road oil will be \$2.19 a gallon this year. Application for road oil will start when the road crew has the roads ready to apply the road oil. The Road Oil will be advertised this month. We received one bid for state approved type 4 red cinders. It was from S. Androlunis at a rate of \$46.07 a ton. Mark made a motion to accept the bid from S. Androlunis, Franklin seconded and all agreed. Fuel bids will be received in May.

New Business: Correspondence and emails were distributed. There is nothing new with permits/building permits. There was no new well NOI received and the township received one subdivision prior to the meeting which was the Crown subdivision. The board found no adverse comment to the Crown Subdivision.

Old Business. There is nothing new with the grants for an addition to the Township building for a shower unit. There is nothing new to report on the Seniors Grant program. Kepner is working with Steve Kehoe on the Safe running speed road requirements. Kepner is still working on getting an ordinance drafted for review to pass within the next several months; she needs the prior ordinance drafted years ago. Psats convention is April 19th-22nd: 2026, Bill, Matt, Mark, Joe and Lori will be attending this year. The BCTOA Spring Dinner is May 14th, 2026 from 5-8 at the Grand Victorian Inn, Sayre.

The next regular meeting will be on May 4th, 2026 at 5pm.
